For the past two years, much of those events were related to the Citys Climate Action and Adaptation Plan (CAAP) and the CAAP work will continue as the City works through the implementation phase. She has a B.S. in Chemical Engineering from Texas A and M in Kingsville. Prior to working for CPS Energy, Angela worked for Luminant/TXU, the utility company in the Dallas Fort Worth area, as a gas fired Power Plant Engineer and at that gas fired plant she also had the role of Environmental Coordinator for air, waste and water. She also worked as a Chemistry Lab Supervisor at TXUs Comanche Peak Nuclear Power Station and led a team of 21 technicians in 3 labs. Angela is on the Large Public Power Council Environmental Task Force. She chaired the San Antonio Chamber of Commerce Energy and Sustainability Committee in 2019. She has represented CPS Energy while serving on various other industry and community committees and Boards such as the Green Spaces Alliance of South Texas Board for 3 years (2016 -2018) and the Alamo Area Council of Governments (AACOG) Air Technical Committee for 6 years, she also serves as alternate on the AACOG Board.
